## How does someone get "refugee status"?

- Usually, through an interview in the country that they are living in now to determine whether they meet the refugee definition. This process is conducted by either:
  - a) The Government of the country
  - b) The UNHCR (United Nations Refugee Agency)
  - c) No one
- Sometimes, refugee status is determined on a "prima facie" basis (a group declaration)
- Since 2012, to be sponsored by a Group of Five or Community Sponsor, the Principal Applicant MUST have a REFUGEE STATUS RECOGNITION DOCUMENT unless they are Syrian or Iraqi, as there is currently a temporary exemption of this regulation for Syrians and Iraqis.
- Groups of Five or Community Sponsor applications without a copy of this
  document are not accepted by CIC (unless they are for Syrian or Iraqi refugees)
